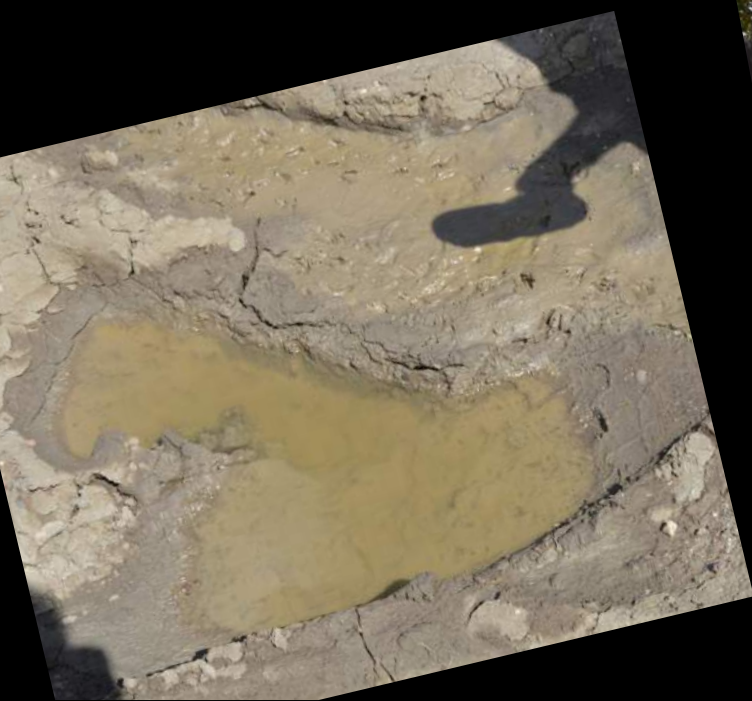


Flashback to Field Trip Day!
